- have a previous EP or album available on recognised platforms
- provide at least a 30% cash co-contribution to the overall project budget.

Note: For the purpose of this program contemporary music refers to artists and acts performing new and original music.

Artforms not supported through this program are:

- experimental music and sound art
- contemporary classical, opera, choral and ensembles
- music theatre
- working in and with community music groups.

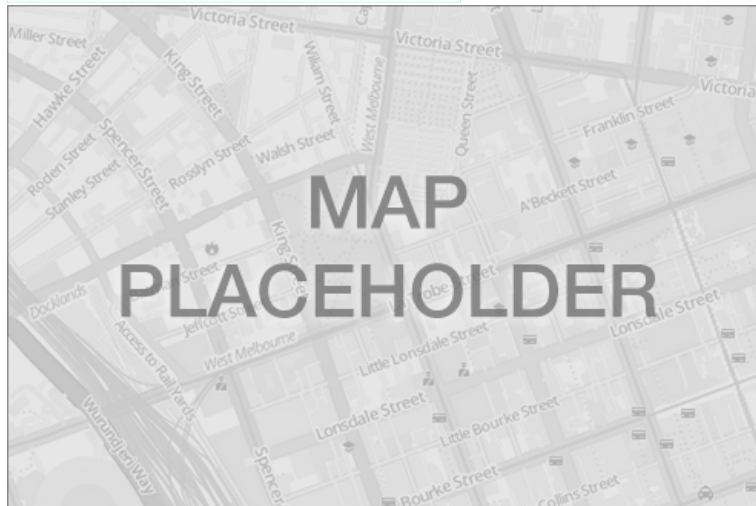

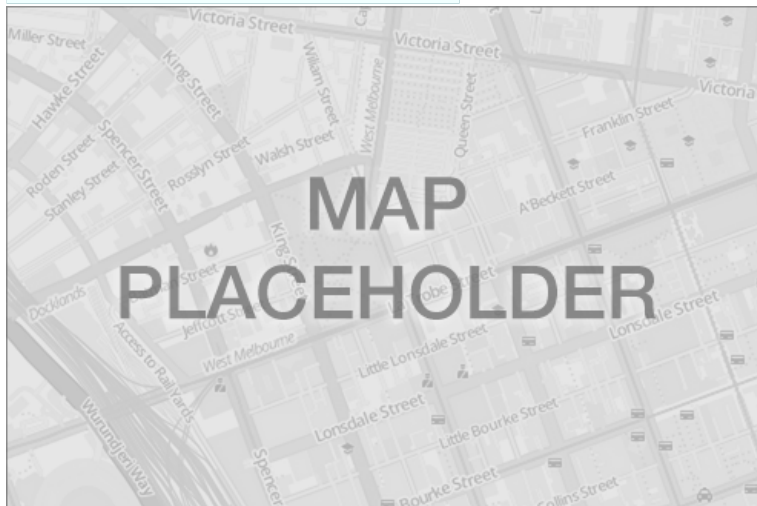
